From the airport take the metro to Kongens Nytorv (13 mins).

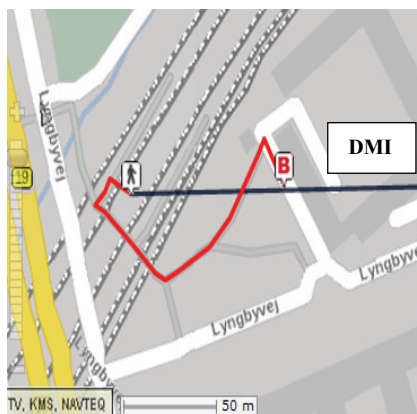
Water front hotel, close to Amalienborg (the Queen's castle), and fashionable shopping streets.

Getting to the Danish Meteorological Institute (DMI)

Address: DMI, Lyngbyvej 100. Please ask for your host in the reception.

By public transportation

Ryparken station is situated very close to DMI, and you can get there very easily from central Copenhagen. After descending the stairs from the platform, take the exit on your left. After exiting the building, take the metal stairs on the left. See the map below for directions.



From The Central Station

Take the S-train line A (Blue) towards Farum and get off at Ryparken St. Monday to Saturday the train goes every 10 minutes at daytime and takes approx. 15 minutes.

From Kongens Nytorv

Take the bus line 15 towards Østerbro/Ryparken St. and get off at Ryparken St.. The bus goes every 10 minutes in the day time and takes approx. 20 minutes. Ask the bus driver to stop at Ryparken St.

From Copenhagen Airport

Take the Øresund Train towards Helsingør and get off at Hellerup St. It takes approx. 30 min. and goes every 5 minutes from the airport. At Hellerup St., change to the S-train line F (Yellow, goes every 5 min.) towards Ny Ellebjerg St. and get off at Ryparken St. (next station right after Hellerup St.).

Note that the normal route Airport-DMI with metro to Nørreport, changing to S-train line A towards Farum, is problematic currently, as there is construction work at Nørreport!

For other directions with public transport the link <http://www.rejseplanen.dk/> is very helpful (you change language in the upper right corner).

A single 2-zone ticket for all public transportation in Copenhagen city area costs 24 DKK (valid for one hour) and 48 DKK from the airport. A 10-ride ticket costs 140 DKK. From the airport to the city or to the DMI you need 3 zones, 36 DKK for one hour, or 190 DKK for 10 rides.

Going by taxi

Typically a Taxi to DMI will cost around 300 DKK from the airport and 150 DKK from the centre of Copenhagen.
